Argentina, Australia, Chile, New Zealand and South Africa combined have a wine history of more than 1000 years! Some interesting facts.

Australia

In 1788, the first fleet of Anglo-Saxon settlers carried vines in their cargo. The first vineyards were established in 1823.

Argentina

Depended on Spanish colonization to bring over vitis vinifera vines in 1541. First recorded vineyard at Santiago del Estero in 1557.

Chile

Chilean wine history goes back to the 16th century with the arrival of the Spanish conquistadors.

New Zealand

Missionaries planted first vines on the North Island in 1819. Wine making began in 1836.

South Africa

South African wine production started at the Cape of Good Hope. The first grapes were crushed in 1652. Its fame grew in Europe with the great dessert wines of Constantia in the 18th century.

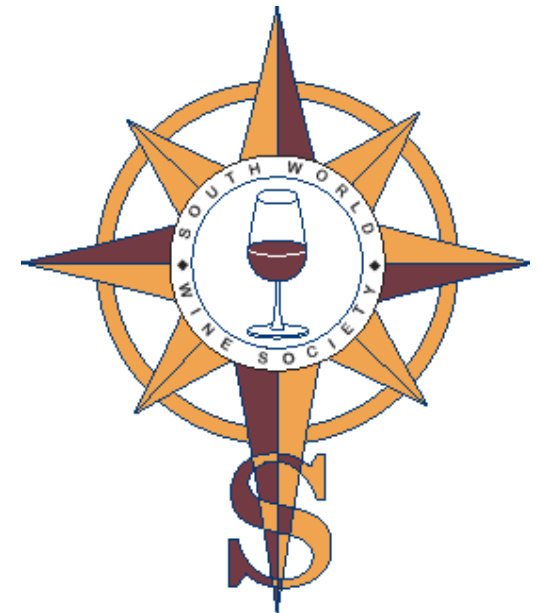
